OLD BUSINESS:

- LMSC FOP (Financial Operating Policies) – The USMS FOG is being updated this year. SPMS FOP will be updated after Convention and will then be posted for review.

NEW BUSINESS:

Convention Proposal Review: The following proposals were pulled sand discussed. Long Distance Proposals

LD-9 – Clarify escort craft.

LD-10 – No definition of drafting – No swimming behind craft.

Both the Open Water and Long Distance Committees recommend a yes vote.

LD-13 – Event hosts can require all participants to wear safety buoys. If they are required you will be scored as equals and if they are optional you will split in divisions. The type of buoys will be up to the meet director and it will be included in the event information. Recommend a yes vote.



LD-14 – If a race is restarted, consult with the Safety Director, however the Referee has the final say.

Legislation Proposals

L-43 – Not recommended to pass by Legislation Committee. Delegates will need to hear discussion at Convention prior to voting.

Rules Proposals

R-5 – Not recommended to pass by Rules Committee. Separate category, meets cannot support it.

R-6 – Recommend as amended. Puts a policy in the rulebook. Our policy is now in alignment with IOC and USA Swimming.
