The past month I have been working on communications with clubs and unattached swimmers in an effort to encourage unattached swimmers to consider attaching to a convenient club of their choice that welcomes satellite swimmers. Many unattached swimmers do not live near any Masters Club Workout Pools and so chose to be unattached. As a satellite swimmer these members could enjoy camaraderie, swimming with club members on relays at meets, hanging with club members at swim meets, attending club socials, and receiving other club member perks. Satellite swimmers do not pay monthly dues. So, November 1, instead of renewing with USMS as unattached, attach to a club of your choice if you are currently unattached. Maybe do a drop in swim with a club to try them out if you can. USMS Members are allowed to change clubs 3 times per calendar year at no charge. So, if you don't like your club, transfer to a different club, but keep swimming!

At the recent USMS Relay Meeting in Houston October 18-20 I exchanged ideas with other club members and learned some things that I intend to use and share. I attended many educational sessions. In September I also attended the USMS Annual Convention which was on Zoom with lengthy House of Delegate sessions.

To help grow your club, invite local College Club Swimmers to join you for workouts and swim meets. Maybe they are attending local junior college or city college where there is no swim team at all. Maybe these high school graduates are just working and would love a swim team environment again.
