Nancy Reno is the coach of the Conejo Valley Multisport Masters. The club trains primarily out of Cal Lutheran University in Thousand Oaks. In 2018, Nancy's club had multiple SPMS Champions, 2 Pan Am Champions, 14 top ten relays, the SPMS LCM Regionals World Record Mixed 800 Free Relay, the open water national champion, 5 All Americans, hosted the Annual Matt Biondi Classic Swim Meet in March, and 22 FINA Top Ten Relays and Individuals. This looks like a decade of work packed into one year, and this was done without the support of an age group team.

Over the years, Nancy has contributed multitudes to her team, SPMS and Masters swimming as a whole. Some of the amazing things include: YouTube technique videos with over 71,000 views; successfully started two USMS masters teams over the past 10 years; served as USMS National Championship on Deck Coach 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016; presented at SPMS Coaches Conventions 2010, 2011, 2012 and USMS National Convention in 2009 and 2010; served as masters mentor coach to new young coaches; created a pre-masters swim program in 2013; authored LA Times, Swimming World, and Weight Watchers articles; and won 2009 Speedo U.S. Masters Swimming Coach of the Year Award.

The extent of Nancy's body of work is extremely lengthy and I haven't even included all the significant data that came in from her team. PLUS she still competes in some age groups above 25 – 29. So congratulations to Nancy Reno as Coach of the Year 2018!



The purpose of the SPMS Swimmer of The Year award is to recognize SPMS swimmers each year who have displayed exemplary commitment to Masters swimming, achieved personal success at SPMS swim meets and/or open water events, and have been an inspiration to others.



Jonny swims with Los Angeles Peninsula Masters, and is also an aspiring 2020 Paralympian. Despite the fact that Jonny has had a lifelong love of the water, his parents, themselves coaches and masters swimmers, only learned that people with autism are eligible for Paralympic competition while watching the Rio Olympic Games.

Jonny has since been on a fast and furious path to qualify for Tokyo 2020. Already he has set multiple US Paralympian records ranging in distance from the 50 to the 1500 free, as well as in butterfly, breaststroke, and individual medley events. Some of these records have been set at Masters meets.

Jonny has been an inspiration for many Masters swimmers who have competed against him or just had the privilege of talking with him or watching him swim. We look forward to watching him as he reaches his goal of swimming at the 2020 Paralympic Games.

Sanction by Southern Pacific Masters Swimming for USMS, Inc.

Facility: Mission Viejo Pool is an outdoor, 25 yd. by 50 m competition pool at the Marguerite Aquatic Center, 27474 Casa Del Sol, Mission Viejo. The length of the competition course without a bulkhead is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 107.2.1.

Directions: From the north or south, take the 1-5 Freeway to the Alicia Parkway exit in Mission Viejo. Go east (away from the ocean) to Trabuco Road. Tum right on Trabuco to Marguerite Parkway. Go left on Marguerite to Casa Del Sol, tum right onto Casa Del Sol, and tum into the driveway for pool parking. There will be no parking in reserved tennis spaces.

Entries: The pre-entry postmark deadline is Wednesday, January 9th, 2019. Deck registration is permitted. Deck entries will close at 7:45 a.m. for the 500 yd. Freestyle and 400 yd. Individual Medley, and at 10:00 a.m. for all other events. Age on January 13th determines age group for the meet. You must be at least 18 to compete. **Swimmers are limited to entering a total of 5 individual events.**

Seeding: All events will be deck seeded slowest to fastest, by entered time, ages and sexes combined. Check-in is not required in order to be deck seeded, except swimmers must check in to swim the 500 and 1000 yd. Freestyle and the 400 yd. Individual Medley.

Relays: All relays will be deck entered on SPMS relay forms available at the meet. Relay fees are \$5.00 per relay due upon entry. For each relay swimmer who is not entered in individual events, a fee of \$15.00 and a signed liability release must be submitted with the relay entry.

Awards: Individual: MVN ribbons for places 1 to 3. Relay: MVN ribbons for first place.

Entry Fees: On line entries are preferred on Club Assistant. \$35.00 per swimmer flat fee. Deck entries allowed for a total of \$40.00.

Sanction by Southern Pacific Masters Swimming for USMS, Inc.

Facility: UNLV Buchanan Natatorium, Jim Reitz Pool. Indoor 50-meter by 25-yard pool. There is no postal address; do not use the university's generic Maryland Pkwy address. Location is on E. Harmon Ave, 1000 feet east of the intersection of Harmon Ave and Swenson St, Las Vegas, NV. Map coordinates: 36.112081,-115.147381. Very close to McCarran airport, Hard Rock Hotel & Casino, and Hyatt Place. The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 107.2.1 but as a bulkhead course, is subject to length confirmation. Eligibility of times for USMS Top 10 and records will be contingent on verification of bulkhead placement.

Directions: From 15 North, take 215 East toward McCarran Airport. Continue onto McCarran Airport Connector. Continue onto Swenson St. Turn right onto E. Harmon Ave. Continue 1000 feet to Parking Lot L on your left. Parking Lot L is available for free to non-students on weekends. Walk north on asphalt path toward Buchanan Natatorium entrance on right (tennis courts on your left).

Rules: Swimmers must be USMS members registered for 2019. United States Masters Swimming rules will govern. Current SPMS meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this form. The meet referee will be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to meet referee. All events are timed final. Swimmers are limited to a total of 5 individual events. Age on January 19, 2019 determines age group for the meet. You must be at least 18 to compete.

Entries: The pre-entry postmark deadline is Jan 16, 2019. Online entries will close Wednesday, January 16, 2019 at 11:59pm. Deck entry is permitted until 3:30pm for events 1-6 and 4pm for events 7-18. We encourage deck entry processing "paperless and cashless" on a computer at the pool. Bring your credit card, cash, or check. Entry Limits: the 500 Free will close at 32 entries (4 heats). The 400 IM and 200s of Back, Breast, and Fly will accept deck entries only, not pre-entry. Request entry into these events at the admin desk by 4pm on meet day.

Entry Fees: \$35 per swimmer flat fee.

Seeding: Swimmers will be seeded in heats according to entry time, regardless of age and gender. Heats will be ordered slowest to fastest. Positive check-in is required for the 500 Free and encouraged for all events. Check-in will be available on SwimPhone.com beginning at 8pm on January 18. Positive Check-In for the 500 Free closes at 3:30pm.

Relays: There are no relays in this meet.

Awards: Poker cards with your results stickers may be collected for competition with other swimmers to see who has the best poker hand. The best two poker hands win BIG prizes!
